Description The current implementation of URI#find_proxy will only exclude exact matches when processing the no_proxy environment variable. This diverges from the commonly-used no_proxy specification that supports globs (e.g. <i>.example.com</i> , <i>192.168.</i>). Adding globbing support (perhaps using File.fnmatch) would make URI behave the same as other implementations.
